

## Regional Planning Process Task Force Report PJM Interconnection – Members Committee Information Webinar March 24, 2014

The Regional Planning Process Task Force (RPPTF) last met on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

The RPPTF is finalizing language for a Designated Entity Agreement (DEA) and a Coordination and Interconnection Agreement (CIA) to support PJM proposal windows and selection of designated entities. This is to develop, construct, own and operate greenfield transmission projects. Additionally, the RPPTF has moved toward draft OA/OATT redlines associated with developing a cohesive Multi-Driver Approach (MDA) permitting the incorporation of State Agreement/Public Policy projects as part of the PJM RTEP. The draft documents have been reviewed and commented upon over several RPPTF sessions and Stakeholders have submitted final comments. A poll was conducted regarding the draft agreements with the intention of presentation for a first read at the March 27<sup>th</sup> MRC. The RPPTF is working toward a completion timeline that will permit MRC/MC endorsed actions to be filed at FERC in the early second quarter of 2014. The PJM TO's are aware of the existing timeline and are offering cost allocation filings on similar timing.

The RPPTF is also considering refinement to the definition of the term "Supplemental Project" to repair an existing circularity within the current definition and to clarify what occurs if a violation results from the addition of a supplemental project.

Next meeting:

The next RPPTF is April, 1, 2014 at the PJM CTC.
