

MOPR Subsidy Guidance Update

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- To provide further clarity and reduce uncertainty, PJM and the Market Monitor will work together to develop and maintain a non-exhaustive list of programs, based on information provided by Capacity Market Sellers, that they consider to be a State Subsidy, or not, and post this list in a guidance document.

- This guidance document is not intended to constitute legal advice as to whether or not a program is a State Subsidy
- It is ultimately the Capacity Market Seller's responsibility to ensure that they correctly certify whether its Capacity Resource is subject to a State Subsidy, irrespective of any guidance provided by PJM and the Market Monitor.

- Requests for program review will be submitted through the IMM's MIRA system
- PJM and the IMM will review requests collaboratively
- Direct response to requesting entity will be provided through MIRA.
- Public notice of all determinations will be posted to PJM website
 - Where difference in determination exists between PJM and IMM, both determinations will be noted

- Requirements document has been developed for MIRA system enhancements
- Education on request submission will be provided at an upcoming stakeholder meeting.
