Informational Section

DEDSTF Update

The Designated Entity Design Standards Task Force (DEDSTF) last met on 1/24/2017. At that meeting the three sub groups (Substations, lines and protection) continued discussions on the organization/development of the Design Standards as well as the process of reviewing the existing materials. The DEDSTF expects to bring a first draft of the minimum requirements document to the March or April PC meeting. The next meeting of the DEDSTF is 2/16/2017, all registrations are available on the DEDSTF website.

Order 1000 Update

A Special PC Session on Order 1000 was held on January 13th. An additional session is scheduled for February 10, 2017 (9am – 12 Noon). The focus of the upcoming session is the review of the draft Manual 14F on Competitive Planning Processes.

Tie Line Process

In order to address concerns with obtaining important tie line information for modeling, PJM will update the Manual 3A with the operational requirements previously discussed with draft M14C tie line changes. The preferred timeline for submittal of the wires-to-wires agreement will not be incorporated into the PJM manuals as the FERC rules already address the filing requirements. Therefore, changes to M14C previously discussed will not be necessary as the operational requirements will be covered in M3A.
