



# FERC Ruling on PJM's Order 845 Filing

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January 7, 2020

- May 22, 2019 – PJM submits compliance filing for 10 reforms in Order 845 and 845-A (Docket ER19-1958-000)
  - 18 interveners
  - 3 comments and protests filed
- December 17, 2019 – FERC issues Order on Compliance Filing
  - Six of the 10 reforms accepted
- February 17, 2020 – Compliance filing due for four reforms
- April 1, 2020 – Effective date for all changes (new queues and existing interconnection customers)

- Accepted
  - Definition of Contingent Facilities
  - Identification process
- Required Compliance Filing
  - Add technical screens/analysis and thresholds to Tariff
  - Information currently captured in PJM Manuals

- Accepted
  - Ability to use the existing Interconnection Service Agreement for Provisional Interconnection Service
- Required Compliance Filing
  - Define frequency for studying and updating the MFO for Provisional Interconnection Service

- PJM proposal
  - Expedited process within the queue to evaluate impacts of surplus units
  - Thermal, short circuit and stability screen to ensure no later projects are impacted
  - Projects that impacted later queues could remain as a 0 MW project and be treated similar to a facility with capability greater than MFO
- FERC position
  - Surplus units cannot affect the system and therefore do not required screening or analysis
  - Process must exist outside of the queue

# Material Modifications and Incorporation of Advanced Technologies

- Transmittal letter consistent with the requirements of Order 845
- Proposed Tariff language inconsistent with transmittal letter

- First read (PC) for proposed Manual changes for accepted reforms
- Update for Tariff changes for Compliance Filing

Mar 2020

- First read (MRC) for proposed Manual changes for accepted reforms
- PC endorsement for proposed Manual changes for accepted reforms

Apr 2020

- MRC endorsement for proposed Manual changes for accepted reforms

May 2020  
or later

- FERC action on compliance filing
- PC review of proposed Manual changes for updated reforms
