Product	Date	Issue
Data Miner	<b>September 7</b>	A security misclassification caused participants and PJM personnel to be unable to access Data Miner for about 90 minutes. PJM fixed the security classification to restore access to Data Miner.
Data Miner	<b>September 10</b>	After a planned Data Miner release, a long running job caused a slowdown of Data Miner which prevented feeds from being updated. PJM fixed the issue and is working on a long term solution.

Product	Date	Issue
FTR Center	<b>September 15</b>	<p>Participants reported bid submission errors and slow performance in FTR Center starting around 1600 EPT during the final hour of bidding for the October auction. PJM took several actions including stopping internal processes to free up capacity to process bids, restarting services and extending the bidding window until 2100 EPT.</p> <p>PJM is working on longer term solutions to ensure FTR Center can process bids as needed.</p>
