

- On December 11, 2023, the PJM Board approved a set of proposed projects to expand the transmission system to accommodate electricity demand growth, generator retirements and future capacity needs in the PJM footprint.
- Approx. \$5 billion of new build will meet the reliability needed for data center load growth in Virginia and Maryland, combined with widespread effects from the deactivation of more than 11,000 MW of generation.
