### Administration

- 1. Welcome, Announcements and Anti-trust and Code of Conduct announcement
  - A. Roll was called.
  - B. Minutes from the 07/17/2017 meeting were approved as final.
  - C. Additional agenda item:

Mr. Jack O'Neill, PJM, reviewed the Load Management report (posted with meeting materials). There were no Load Management events, so the report focuses on testing. Overall, testing performance was 153% over the committed value and there was \$3.7 million in penalties which corresponds to 8% of total revenue.

- D. Brief update/discussion of DR related activity in other stakeholder groups:
  - a. MRC a new Senior Task Force was approved that focuses on Summer DR and other possible alternatives. If the DRS will be ½ day for the rest of the year, the new task force may be scheduled for the afternoon on the same day.
  - b. Order 831 the compliance filing was made at FERC and corresponding Manual changes are going through the stakeholder process which impact DR. The first read was at the last MRC on 8/24/2017.

# PRD Review for CP Requirements

2. PJM reviewed and updated the Components in the matrix and added over performance/bonus Payments. Examples were reviewed of PRD proposed nominations, M&V and event penalties. Discussion will continue at the next meeting.

### Energy Efficiency RERRA Review

3. PJM collected stakeholder interests and reviewed the components, which were taken from the current RERRA process for DR registrations, as EE does not have any RERRA requirements today. A suggestion was made to have RERRA review apply to EE provider and not do and EDC account number specific review since EE process is different for DR process.

## Monthly DR Activity Report and Hot Day Report

4. Mr. James McAnany, PJM, reviewed the most recent DR Activity Report and the Hot Day Report from July 21st and 22nd. Figures 1 through 9 are no longer preliminary as the registration period has ended. On the Hot Day report, an interesting slide showed the instantaneous load for the BGE zone, where the impact of DR can clearly be seen.

## Order 831 - Offer Verification

5. Ms. Andrea Yeaton, PJM. Reviewed DR Hub and Markets Gateway enhancements to support Demand Response for Order 831. Starting Nov. 1, all registration offers will be capped at \$1000 unless incremental costs with supporting documentation have been submitted in DR Hub. After entry of the higher costs, the new energy offer cap will be available for use the next calendar day.
