Analogy: 4-Part Communication: 230kV Capacitors



- NEW Program!
- Fall Timeframe: September 27- November 5, 2021
- How does it work?
 - A member, or members, schedule a drill with PJM
 - PJM and member(s) work out the details
 - Drill happens, hours issued, etc.



Must occur on a Tu, W, Th from September 27- November 5

- Drills will be scheduled on a first-come, first served basis but parties wishing to schedule a second drill will be lower priority than parties scheduling their first
- GO/GOps/MOCs wishing to take part in a drill must schedule with their TOs

Scheduling Deadline: 23:59:59EPT May 31, 2021

- Invitations are very important for compliance purposes
