





Queues Timeline



- 734 projects eligible for Transition Cycle 1 (AE1 through AG1)
 - 112 withdrawn*
 - 622 (85%) sufficient Readiness submissions received*
- Small subset of projects identified as eligible to start work on GIAs

- Developers will have **only one chance** to address PM comments.
- Everything must be cured with first re-submission, within 5 business days of PM marking the submission in QP.
- All projects that provide satisfactory responses to all PJM comments will be accepted and move forward.

- Projects that meet the following requirements will begin GIA/WMPA drafting
 - Analysis complete for LF/SC/Stability with no upstream queue dependencies
 - **PJM analysis confirms project is clean or first to cause locked**
 - **Project results cannot be impacted by other project decisions or movement to Transition Cycle #1**
 - Facilities Study complete from TO
 - Readiness Deposit and Site Control provided by developer, and reviewed and accepted by PJM
 - Developer GIA/WMPA inputs received
- We are identifying projects that are ready as they achieve these requirements. We have started drafting GIAs.

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
