The LC sector representatives recently had the opportunity to discuss potential General Session topics with PJM staff. We understand PJM is contemplating two separate panels, the first to focus on the Intersection of de-carbonization and reliability, and the second to take that concept a step further and consider markets and efficiency. We believe that these panels will be engaging and timely. As potential subtopics, the sector representatives suggest balancing requirements, the future of LMP, the interconnection queue and transmission enhancements, and efficiencies created from demand response and distributed energy resources. We look forward to continuing to engage with the Board and PJM staff to plan a lively and informative Session for the Board, Members, and staff alike.
