Progress Update

- PJM conducted EDC coordination workshop on DER in which PJM provided a brief overview of Order 2222, PJM's compliance timeline, and reviewed in more detail the RTO and distribution company coordination directives in the Order.
- PJM solicited feedback from different distribution companies on their viewpoints regarding the Order and the specific coordination directives. PJM heard from a number of distribution companies including PPL, First Energy, Pepco, Duquesne, PSEG, and Dominion. DER aggregators Enel X and CPower also provided comments.
- PJM staff reviewed an initial framework for distribution company coordination and solicited input and feedback from stakeholders. PJM staff discussed operational requirements for the Order along with the existing demand response EDC review process and REERA coordination.
