IRS Background



- Formed as the Intermittent Resources Working Group (IRWG) in November 2008, and reformed as a Task Force in late 2010.
 - Addressed numerous issues specific to Intermittent Resources in the areas of Operations & Reliability, Energy Markets, Capacity Markets, and Interconnection.
 - Its last assignment was completed in October 2014.
- Reformed as the Intermittent Resources Subcommittee (IRS) by MIC on February 11, 2015.
 - Primary purpose is to provide a stakeholder forum through which PJM can communicate updates, disseminate information, and discuss topics specific to Intermittent Resource (IR) owners and operators.
 - The subcommittee conducts business primarily via conference calls held on a quarterly basis.
- Proposal is to sunset the IRS and incorporate its responsibilities into the new Distributed and Inverter-based Resources Subcommittee (DIRS).
