

# **Regulation Market Redesign**

#### **Issue Source**

PJM and IMM are bringing forward this issue. These issues were originally addressed in the Regulation Market Issues Sr. Task Force in 2017 and resulted in a FERC filing (EL18-87) which was ultimately rejected by FERC in March 2018.

#### **Issue Content**

Work is to address regulation market design flaws and potential enhancements including regulation signal design, regulation performance scoring, regulation requirement, regulation market clearing and regulation market settlement.

#### **Key Work Activities and Scope**

Key work activities include:

- 1) Regulation market education.
- Evaluate the benefits factor curve and proscribed RegA/RegD commitment percentages.
- 3) Evaluate how the benefits factor curve and mileage ratio are applied within the regulation market optimization and settlement.
- 4) Evaluate regulation signal formation, including the Reg D conditional neutrality and mileage calculation.
- 5) Evaluate self-schedule and the zero offer resources in the commitment process and impacts on the energy market
- 6) Evaluate Regulation offers and adjusted cost calculation, including the lost opportunity cost schedules and calculation.
- 7) Evaluate regulation testing score and regulation service score methodology.
- 8) Propose modifications to Regulation Market to address any issues raised in the evaluation of the regulation market design from activities 1 through 7 above.

### **Expected Deliverables**

- 1) OATT/OA changes resulting from the key work activities
- 2) Changes to M-11, M-12 and M-28 resulting from the key work activities

### **Decision-Making Method**

Tier 1, consensus on a single proposal

### **Stakeholder Group Assignment**

Given that there are both operational and markets issues involved with this work, PJM proposes creation of a new Sr. Task Force that would report to MRC.
