

- Review Placing a Bid Count Limit on Up Tos
 - Proposed Limit of 3000
 - Only used in extreme circumstances
 - May ask large players to reduce to values above that
- Agree on Method to count bids
- Review removing Virtual language out of tariff and placing in Manual for Virtuals and Up Tos
- Ask for Endorsement next Meeting

- Hours bid with same source, sink, MW and price will be counted as one bid, regardless of whether they are contiguous
- If either source, sink, MW or price is different then it will be counted as different bid.
- Examples

Source = A, Sink = B, Price = \$1, MW = 10 HE1-HE24 -- 1 Bid

Source = A, Sink = B, Price = \$1, MW = 10 HE1-HE7, HE24 -- 1 Bid

Source = A, Sink = B, Price = \$1, MW = 10 HE1-HE7, HE10, HE24 -- 1 Bid

Source = A, Sink = B, Price = \$1, MW = 10 HE1-HE7, MW=20 HE 24 – 2 Bids

Source = A, Sink = B, Price = \$1, MW = 10 HE1-HE7, Price=\$5 HE 24 – 2 Bids

Note : Schedule 9 bid count is different than the bid count above. This bid count is strictly for the enforcement of up-to bid limit per Company
