

System Restoration Strategy Task Force

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Due to industry developments such as new environmental regulations, NERC CIP standards and increasing cost of Black Start generation, PJM foresees a potential future reliability issue with the current method of System Restoration Planning.

This Task Force will examine the current System Restoration Planning process to determine its viability and efficiency moving forward and recommend any changes to the System Restoration strategy and associated procurement, cost allocation, and compensation methods resulting from the recommended changes to the MRC for approval.

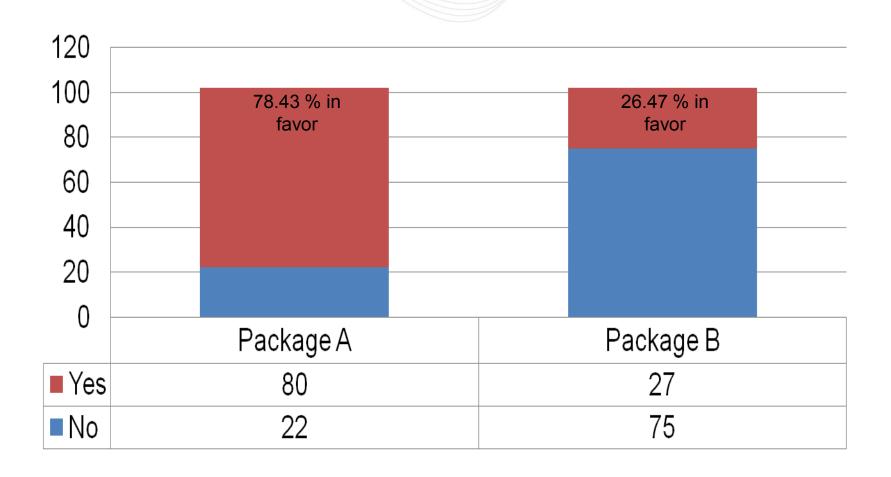
