- PJM has investigated the impact of PJM EOL Package on Governing Documents and Manuals
- PJM's Package does not impact Governing Documents
  - No impact to CTOA
  - No impact to Operating Agreement
- PJM's Package will result in modifications to Manual 14B
- Existing provisions within the CTOA and Operating Agreement define PJM's authority to effectuate the PJM EOL Package

- Under the CTOA, section 4.1.4, the transmission owners are required “to provide information reasonably requested by PJM to prepare the Regional Transmission Expansion Plan and shall otherwise cooperate with PJM in such preparation.”
- Under the OA, schedule 6, section 1.5.4 provides that:
  - the transmission owners are required to provide to PJM on an annual or periodic basis as specified by PJM any information and data reasonable required by PJM to perform the RTEP, including but not limited to the following:
    - (iv) the current Local Plan
    - (v) all criteria, assumptions and models used by the transmission owners, such as those used to develop Supplemental Projects.
- Section 1.5.4(a) also states: “The data required under this Section shall be provided in the form and manner specified by PJM.”
