

Preemption of Non-firm Transmission Service

Issue Source

PJM Transmission Service Department is bringing this issue forward for consideration. The issue is driven by compliance requirement changes within the North American Energy Standards Board (NAESB) version 3.2 Business Practice Standards, which become enforceable on October 27, 2021.

Issue Content

The work will finalize Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) revisions to address issues related to preemption of non-firm transmission service reservations.

Key Work Activities and Scope

The stakeholders will review all proposed OATT revisions, presenting the finalized version to relevant stakeholder committees.

Expected Deliverables

Provide updated OATT language changes to relevant stakeholder groups. Also included will be any necessary documentation including an associated section 205 FERC filing.

Decision-Making Method

Tier 1, consensus (unanimity)

Stakeholder Group Assignment

This issue will use the Quick Fix (QF) process in accordance with Manual 34 section 8.6.1, and will be presented to the Operating Committee (OC) for approval.

Expected Duration of Work Timeline

New NAESB requirements associated with non-firm transmission service preemption become enforceable on October 27, 2021. An accelerated timeline is needed to ensure the proposed 205 filing receives a FERC response prior to the enforcement date. As such, PJM is proposing to review and vote on the issue charge and proposed solution upon first read at the July 15th OC, and July 28th MRC and MC meetings.
