This update makes 4.4 consistent with more recent PJM Compliance Bulletin regarding COM-001-3, Requirement 10</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional text qualifying that PJM members only need to notify PJM, or other parties, of Interpersonal Communication failure if all redundant modes and means (ex. Cell, radio, satellite) have failed. As long as there is a viable method of Interpersonal Communication, COM-001-3 R10 does not apply.</li> </ul>
