



Planning Committee PJM Interconnection October 8, 2015

Administration

Administrative Items

- A. Mr. Herling called the meeting to order and asked if the Planning Committee had any additional items for the agenda. There were no suggestions for additional agenda items.
- B. Mr. Herling asked Ms. Thomas to review the meeting minutes of the September 10, 2015 Planning Committee meeting. Mr. Pratzon then made a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Scarpignato seconded the motion. In a voice vote, the Planning Committee approved the September 10, 2015 Planning Committee minutes.
- C. Mr. Sims provided an update regarding the 2015 RTEP Proposals Windows. There will be 21 proposals recommended at the October PJM Board from Window 1. Proposal Window 2 recommendations will be discussed at the October 8th TEAC.
- D. Mr. Gledhill provided an update regarding the Earlier Queue Submittal Task Force. The first meeting was September 17th to work on charter, education and design components. The next meeting will be on October 29th.
- E. Mr. Herman provided an update regarding the DEDSTF. The first meeting will be October 12th.
- F. Mr. Thompson provided an update on Model On Demand. There are 240 projects that have been uploaded so far. All projects for 2017 should be uploaded by Friday, October 9th. All project models through 2020 should be submitted by mid-November.
- G. Mr. Berner provided the Long Term Firm Meeting Update. Several educational sessions have taken place. The next meeting will be Friday, October 9th.
- H. Mr. Fraley, from First Energy, discussed the removal of the Black Oak 500/138kV #3 SPS.
- I. Ms. Glatz discussed the Voltage Threshold language changes. Based on member feedback, PJM is evaluating the proposed Voltage Threshold language and will provide a first read at the upcoming Planning Committee meetings.
- J. The 2016 PJM Meeting schedule has been posted on pjm.com under the Planning Committee site.
- K. The Manual 03 Version 48 has been posted online.

Endorsements/Approvals

2. Winter Study Criteria

Mr. Sims reviewed the Manual 14B additions regarding Winter Study Criteria. . The Winter Study analysis was posted with the September 10th TEAC material. For the Winter Study Criteria, Load Deliverability, Generator Deliverability, N-1-1 Thermal and Voltage analysis were performed. Gas

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contingencies were analyzed for the Winter Study and further evaluation will be performed as to the likelihood of these extreme events. Members asked what would be the study year of the Winter analysis and if Immediate Need projects would be assigned to Transmission Owners with violations. Mr. Sims explained that analysis would begin on the 2021 case and possibly a near term 3 year case where violations would be reviewed individually. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the Winter Criteria changes. Ms. Syners made a motion to endorse and Ms.Krizenoskas seconded. IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE MANUAL 14B WINTER STUDY CRITERIA CHANGES. There were no votes of opposition or abstention.

3. Energy Market Uplift

Mr. McGlynn reviewed the Manual 14B additions regarding incorporating energy market uplift in the planning process. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the 2015 IRM Study Results. Mr. Kopinski made a motion to endorse and Mr. Bailey seconded. IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE MANUAL 14B CHANGES REGARDING INCORPORATING ENEGERY MARKET UPLIFT IN THE PLANNING PROCESS. There were no votes of opposition or abstention.

4. PARTF Update

Mr. Berner reviewed the requirements which will be established to allow PAR's to obtain transmission and withdrawal rights. Mr. Berner explained that injection or withdrawal rights are not for existing PARs. Members requested that draft manual language explicitly state that injection and withdrawal rights are for new PARs. Mr. Berner will be back to present manual language changes to meet the PARTF requirements when the remaining M14E language changes are prepared for the Planning Committee.

5. NERC TPL Standards Update

Mr. Herman reviewed the Manual 14B changes regarding NERC TPL -001-4 standards including administrative changes made after the initial September 10th posting. The NERC TPL -001-4 standards are effective January 1st 2016. Mr. Herman will be providing a first read at the October 22nd MRC. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the TPL Standards changes. Mr. Trayers made a motion to endorse and Mr. Scarpignato seconded. **IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE MANUAL 14B NERC TPL -001-4 CHANGES.** There were no votes of opposition or abstention.

6. Earlier Queue Submittal Task Force

Mr. Gledhill reviewed the charter for the Earlier Queue Submittal Task Force. The charter details the mission, group objectives, and expected deliverables to be completed by mid-2016. The charter is posted with the October 10th Planning Committee material. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the charter. Mr. Pratzon made a motion to endorse and Mr. Kopinski seconded. **IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE EARLIER QUEUE SUBMITTAL CHARTER.** There were no votes of opposition or abstention.





7. 2015 IRM Study Results

Mr. Rocha reviewed the 2015 IRM Study Results. The 2015 IRM study results are based on the study assumptions and load model endorsed by the Planning Committee earlier this year. Mr. Wilson from Wilson Economics presented a recommendation to allow IRM and FPR to remain as is or to rerun the study with a different load model. Mr. Rocha answered members' questions regarding IRM study inputs and results. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the 2015 IRM Study Results. Mr. Scarpignato made a motion to endorse and Mr. Trayers seconded. IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE 2015 IRM STUDY RESULTS. There were 110 approvals, 2 votes of opposition, and 36 abstentions.

First Readings

8. Load Forecast Update

Mr. Reynolds reviewed proposed changes to Manual 19 related to enhancements to the load forecast model. The three main changes relate to using End-Use Trends, Weather Variables, and Distributed Solar Generation.

9. NERC/RRO Update

Mr. Kuras provided the Planning Committee with an update on recent NERC activities and PJM compliance activities. Comments and ballots for on-going standard reviews can be found under the October 8th Planning Committee Material. NERC Standards subject to future enforcement can be found under the September 10th Planning Committee Material.

10. Light Load Update Criteria

Mr. Sims reviewed sensitivity analysis regarding Light Load criteria. Mr. Sims discussed updating the MVAR loading to reflect what is happening during the light load period. Mr. Sims discussed using the average capacity factors as bright line to determine if coal or natural gas units should be dispatch in the light load base case.
