

May 21 Order on Rehearing Request and PJM's 2nd Order No. 845 Compliance Filing

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- FERC dismissed the Request for Rehearing/Clarification
- FERC partially accepted PJM's 2nd Order No. 845 compliance filing regarding changes to:
 - Contingent Facilities
 - Provisional Interconnection Service
 - Permissible Technological Advancement
 - Surplus Interconnection Service
- Required an additional, limited compliance filing

- Contingent Facilities – include specific triggering thresholds or criteria to be used to identify contingent facilities in the system impact study (P20);
- Advanced Technologies –
 - Add whether PJM adopts the \$10,000 study deposit or “reasonable alternative (P61); and
 - Clarify that PJM will provide an explanation to the interconnection customer why a technological advancement request is a material modification (P60).
- Surplus Interconnection Service – add detail whether PJM will refund any unused portion of the study deposit (P39).

- Compliance Filing due: September 18, 2020 (120 days from order); and
- Effective Dates granted as requested:
 - November 17, 2020 for Surplus Interconnection Service (180 days from issuance of order); and
 - July 20, 2020 for all other revisions submitted in the February 21 Compliance Filing (60 days from issuance of order).
