- PJM has been making enhancements to how we manage Upgrade ID Requests. Recently, PJM has built the TO Planner application which allows for submitting Supplemental Upgrades. Similarly, PJM has deployed a similar tool for submitting Non-Competitive Baseline upgrades.
- Our internal database has been updated and is now live along with the new applications that are listed above



- As part of these enhancements, PJM streamlined the Parent –
 Child or Parent Component relationships by adding ".0" to
 components that did not have a suffix. For example b3783 became
 b3783.0
- Moving forward, PJM will reverse this action on all previously submitted projects due to legal reasons
- There are a few projects that were submitted to FERC with the ".0" suffix, and those will continue to have that moving forward.
