Emerging Technologies Forum Overview

Advanced Technology Pilot Program Process: Periodic review of application process and types of pilots

Emerging Technologies Work Phases

- 1 Emerging Technology Education on technology or application that could potentially become a pilot
- 2 Active Pilot Project Education and knowledge sharing on active pilot projects
- 3 Completed Pilot Project Review of pilot results, recommendations and value assessment
- 4 Technology Integration Identification and analysis of benefits and obstacles for implementing emerging technologies, including value assessment
- Recommendations

 Recommendations to address identified obstacles and impacts to system operations, system planning and market operations



- Initial survey issued in Oct 2020
 - 11 individual / 9 voting member / 74 members
 - Results: High interest in topics such as DER, new transmission solution technologies, and topology optimization
 - Broad list of technologies of interest for future discussion / investigation / education
- Next step: Re-issue a survey in Q1 2021 to refine input and boost amount and diversity of responses.
