Maryland's leading Eastern Shore golf course has [two finishing holes](#) that are destined to be some of the region's most talked-about. The 17th is a par 3 that stretches 200 yards from the tips. Awaiting the bold player is a dramatic carry over Shoal Creek to a large putting surface guarded by three artfully crafted bunkers. The green is back-dropped by majestic trees and a stunning vista of the broad Choptank River that flows into Chesapeake Bay.

Winery Tour

Located just outside of Cambridge, MD, Layton's Chance Winery sits nestled amongst a landscape of quiet rural farmland, forests, and wetlands. Owned by the Layton family who has been farming this area for generations, the winery is unique in its quest to grow grapes in an area typically reserved for grain. Come see how this local family used ingenuity, agricultural experience and good ole' hard work to adapt and create the area's first every winery and commercial vineyard.

Brewery Tour

Based right here in Cambridge, MD, RaR (Real Ale Revival) Brewing was founded in 2013 by a small group of local, hometown guys. It has enjoyed constant growth ever since, with distribution spanning all over the state of Maryland and beyond. "We built our brewery in an 80-year-old former pool hall and bowling alley with the goal of maintaining the building's history while producing well-balanced American brews 30 barrels at a time. Proudly brewing since the summer of 2013 with no intentions of slowing down, striving to continuously produce products that our community can take pride in".

Guided Bike Tour

This scenic bike tour will take you through the diverse landscape of the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge including marshes, hardwood and loblolly pine forests, as well as open farmland, all from the comfort of a flat, paved surface!

Tours start out with a basic lesson during which we will go over paddling etiquette, proper paddle stroke and maneuvering. Our skilled guides will then lead you on an unforgettable experience of our intricate brackish waterways in search of eagles, osprey, herons and many other species of waterfowl while we share our knowledge of local history and lore. We will be on the lookout for river otters, muskrats, turtles and many others! We even spot whitetail and sika deer roaming the banks as well as the recently endangered Delmarva fox squirrel. You will be amazed at the diversity of this incredible ecosystem!
