Annual Issues Review Process (JOA §9.3.7.2)

- In the 4th quarter, RTOs exchange (completed December 2021)
 - Regional Issues and newly approved projects near the seam
 - New regional issues
 - M2M historical congestion
- RTOs jointly review above in January
- Receive Third Party issues in first quarter, but no less than 30 days before Issues Review IPSAC – *January 18*
- Issues Review IPSAC February 17
 - Held in the first quarter of each year
 - Must provide 60 calendar day notice of scheduled date
 - Stakeholder feedback due 30 days prior to IPSAC





Continued



- Within 45 calendar days after the Issues Review IPSAC the JRPC shall determine the need for a Coordinated System Plan (CSP) study – by April 3
- JRPC notifies the IPSAC of its decision within 5 business days – March 30





Coordinated System Plan



CSP studies could include:

- Interregional Market Efficiency Project (IMEP)
- Targeted Market Efficiency Project (TMEP)
- Interregional Reliability Project (IRP)
- Public Policy
- Ad Hoc studies

JRPC decision is to conduct a 2022 CSP

- Based on ~\$519 million congestion on M2M flowgates in 2020 & 2021
 - Preliminary data presented at February 17, 2022 IPSAC meeting





Coordinated System Plan



IPSAC Meeting April 25, 2022

- Of the preliminary \$519M of congestion
 - \$191M of congestion was determined to be non-persistent or mitigated by future upgrades
 - TMEP study in 2022 covers the remaining \$328M of congestion
 - 23 TMEP study candidates under consideration

IPSAC Meeting July 21, 2022

- Of the 23 TMEP study candidates
 - 19 TMEP candidates eliminated
 - 4 TMEP candidates remain under consideration





Coordinated System Plan



IPSAC Meeting August 26, 2022

Identify final TMEP candidates for congestion mitigation

TMEP Study Timeline

- August
 - Work with facility owners to identify limiting equipment and potential upgrades
- September
 - Complete evaluation of potential upgrades
- October
 - Joint review of results
 - JRPC recommendation to respective RTO Boards
