

# DR Open Registration – Option A/B proposed adjustment

- Change
  - “Note - if zone dispatched for event prior to registration, registration ~~still~~ needs to test for share of **increased** zone commitment.”
- Clarification
  - If new registration included in dispatch pool that has already been dispatched then new registration must test for share of increased zone commitment if zone commitment was increased after the new registration becomes effective. If zone commitment was not increased the registration does not need to test.
  - Dispatch pool = Zone/Subzone, Lead Time, and Resource Type
  - New registration – registration effective after the dispatch pool load management event.

- Potential penalties
  - Daily deficiency penalty OR event penalty OR test penalty (current paradigm)
    - Avoid double penalties
  - If dispatch pool already dispatched then performance already assessed for that portion of capacity commitment
    - Only need to test if commitment has been increased
      - Commitment on day of event compared to commitment used for test purposes (average annual commitment).

If PECO DR (Icap) commitment is increased to 5 MW on 9/2 (after NEW registration becomes effective) then NEW registration must test for 1/7 *1 or 0.143 MW								

Only need to test for increased commitment amount since prior commitment already subject to event penalty
