## (1:15 – 1:45) Elimination of MOPR for DR for 23/24 BRA

2. Pete Langbein discussed the recent FERC outcome that put the filed MOPR rules into effect. This means DR/EE will not be subject to MOPR for 23/24 BRA but still subject to MOPR for 22/23 3<sup>rd</sup> IA.

## (1:45 – 2:00) DR participation in the wholesale markets with critical gas infrastructure loads [Presentation](#)

3. Pete Langbein discussed DR participation with critical gas infrastructure loads, and the idea that PJM could do something in short order around updating the business section in DR Hub so that CSPs could access the database and update equipment as critical gas infrastructure. It was requested that CSPs take this idea back to their companies to determine if there would be any issue with this data being entered into DR Hub.
  - Stakeholders requested that PJM should note what type of facilities fall within the category of critical gas infrastructure so there is a consistent definition.
  - Ken Schisler provided a link to the ERCOT document as to not “reinvent the wheel” on this.
