Ms. Rebecca Gerber discussed the voluntary PJM Markets Certification which will be a new credential that will provide assurance to PJM and Members that an individual has demonstrated knowledge of PJM Markets and business rules in various markets related areas.

The initial test sample will be available between *July 5th – August 31st 2017*. Multiple test candidates will be needed during that time to validate the exam.
