- PJM will be developing a Just-in-Time training module covering the updates to the RRC tool. This will be available in the LMS for companies who wish to use it as part of the Task Reverification process.
- A member asked for clarification on the Communications Protocol Assessment requirement. Per PJM Manual 01, each applicable entity must assess its operators/dispatchers adherence to the Communication Protocols at least once every 12 months. Member Companies may use the PJM LMS to track compliance with this requirement by submitting the Communications Protocol Assessment Form for documentation in the system. Alternatively, Member Companies may opt to use an internal tracking mechanism to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- PJM will be filing an ILA for the 2017 GridEx Exercise.
