PJM Transmission Certification Exam Update

Michael Hoke, PJM, provided the DTS with an update on the PJM Transmission Owner Operator Certification exam. The new exam will be available beginning July 1, 2018. During July and August, the exam will be available without instant scoring. The exam will be unavailable during the month of September, while the new exam is validated and the cut-score is determined.

UPDATE (Sent to DTS on 5/31/2018): Due to scheduling changes with the test vendor, the timeline for the updated PJM Transmission exam has been revised. The new exam will be available beginning August 1, 2018. The test will be available for two months, during which time instant scoring will be unavailable. The exam will be unavailable for the month of October while the test is validated and the cut-score is determined.
