2021 Load Model Time Period Analysis

 Mr. Rocha-Garrido reviewed detailed results of analysis performed by PJM staff regarding the selection of a load model time period for both PJM and the World regions. The analysis focused on the 2025/2026 Delivery Year and followed the procedure approved by the Planning Committee at its July, 2009 meeting.

PJM recommended a 13 year load model based on the years 2001-2013 for use in the 2021 RRS Base Case. PJM also recommended that the World peak be switched to a different July week so that PJM and World peak on the same month but not on the same week.
