1. Mr. Falin opened the meeting and reviewed the agenda. The meeting minutes from the July 12, 2021 meeting were approved and will be posted as final.

2021 Load Model Time Period Analysis

2. Mr. Rocha-Garrido reviewed detailed results of analysis performed by PJM staff regarding the selection of a load model time period for both PJM and the World regions. The analysis focused on the 2025/2026 Delivery Year and followed the procedure approved by the Planning Committee at its July, 2009 meeting.

PJM recommended a 13 year load model based on the years 2001-2013 for use in the 2021 RRS Base Case. PJM also recommended that the World peak be switched to a different July week so that PJM and World peak on the same month but not on the same week.

The RAAS endorsed the 2001-2013 load model for use in the 2021 RRS Base Case.
