

## Cross RTO/ISO Outreach

FTR Group AFMTF Technical Workshop October 20, 2021



- PJM researched MISO, ERCOT, and ISO-NE to better understand tools and features of FTR clearing
  - MISO, ERCOT utilize Nexant iHedge; ISO-NE, PJM utilize GE software
- Based on PJM outreach, no RTO/ISO co-optimizes FTR product types (e.g. month, year)
  - PJM removed this "overlap" feature in 2018 due to poor performance
- Further, with the exception of ERCOT monthly auctions, PJM is the only RTO/ISO that simultaneously clears 24H, On peak and Off peak class types (or "Time-of-use" products) in every auction
- PJM recommends a survey to determine interest in replacing or supplementing the annual and/or 24H ARR/FTR product with more granular products that do not require overlapping during clearing
