*Re: PJM Interconnection, L.L.C., Docket No. ER19-2105-000 and -001  
(Informational Filing)*

Dear Secretary Bose:

The Open Access Transmission Tariff (“Tariff”),<sup>1</sup> Schedule 7, section 11(D), as accepted by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) in its November 5, 2019 Order Accepting and Suspending Proposed Tariff Revisions and Establishing Hearing and Settlement Judge Procedures,<sup>2</sup> requires if, at any time, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) finds that an incorrect input or calculation was used to determine the Border Yearly Charge (“BYC”), PJM must post on its website the correction to any inputs or calculations used to determine the BYC and a variance report documenting changes from the BYC that was based on an incorrect input or calculation.

To that end, after the November 27, 2019 posting of the 2020 BYC Workbook to the PJM website, effective January 1, 2020, PJM was advised of changes to the Network Service Peak Load (“NSPL”) by American Transmission Service Systems, Incorporated (“ATSI”) and American

Electric Power Services Corporation (“AEP”) that necessitated a posting on the PJM website to correct inputs and calculations used to determine the 2020 BYC. Consistent with Tariff, Schedule 7, section 11(E), this filing is being submitted to include the postings made pursuant to Schedule 7, section 11(D). PJM is submitting this filing for informational purposes.

## **I. DESCRIPTION OF THE INFORMATIONAL FILING**

As noted above, PJM was advised of changes to the NSPL by ATSI and AEP after the November 27, 2019 posting of the 2020 BYC Workbook. Although the changes to the transmission owners’ NSPL were minimal, PJM concluded that the inputs and calculations used to determine the 2020 BYC were incorrect and needed to be revised.<sup>3</sup>

Accordingly, pursuant to Tariff, Schedule 7, section 11(D), PJM posted on its website on December 30, 2019: (i) the correction to the inputs and calculations used to determine the BYC; and (ii) a variance report documenting the changes to the BYC.<sup>4</sup>

Because the changes do not affect a BYC currently in effect, the corrected 2020 BYC will go into effect on January 1, 2020, as originally posted on November 27, 2019.

In addition, consistent with Tariff, Schedule 7, section 11(E), PJM is submitting this filing with the Commission with all the information posted on PJM’s website relative to this correction.
