Re: Retirement Notification for Warrior Run

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to Section 113.1 of the PJM Interconnection LLC (“PJM”) Open Access Transmission Tariff (“PJM Tariff”), and in accordance with Section 9 of PJM Manual 14D, AES WR Limited Partnership (“Warrior Run”) hereby submits notice of the Deactivation of the Warrior Run Facility (described below) coal-fired unit.

The “Warrior Run Facility” (“Facility”) is a coal-fired generation facility rated at approximately 205 MW. The Warrior Run Facility is directly and wholly owned by Warrior Run, which is an indirect subsidiary of The AES Corporation.

On June 21, 2023, the Maryland Public Service Commission approved the termination of the Electric Energy Purchase Agreement between Warrior Run and The Potomac Edison Company. The termination became effective on June 29, 2023.

Warrior Run expects to deactivate the Facility on June 1, 2024 (the “Deactivation Date”). Warrior Run will either retire or mothball the Facility on June 1, 2024, and is considering, among other options and generation technologies, converting the existing Facility to burn biomass instead of coal (or in combination with coal). If the Facility is mothballed and converted to biomass fuel, Warrior Run estimates that the Facility would be out of service until January 2026.¹

Please note that pursuant to Section 113.2 of the PJM Tariff and because this Notice was sent prior to September 30, 2023, by November 30, 2023, PJM is required to (1) notify Warrior Run of any reliability impacts resulting from the proposed unit retirement specified herein and (2) provide an initial estimate of the period of time it will take to complete any transmission system reliability upgrades necessary to alleviate the reliability impacts. After receiving such notice and estimate, Warrior Run will review whether to extend the retirement date consistent with maintaining the transmission system reliability in accordance with the PJM Tariff.
