Revisions to Confidentiality*

Dear Secretary Bose:

On November 17, 2020, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. submitted proposed revisions to the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“Operating Agreement”), sections 18.17.6 and 18.17.7. After the filing was submitted, an error was noted in the transmittal letter. Specifically, on page 5 of transmittal letter, in section II where PJM described the proposed revisions to Operating Agreement, section 18.17.6(a), the following highlighted language was inadvertently included in the redlines in error: “or **one of its affiliated entities**’ other reliability or situational awareness tools.” The transmittal letter instead should have read as highlighted below:

18.17.6 Disclosure of EMS and Transmission System Data to Transmission Owners on PJM EMS Terminal and Via Other Reliability or Situational Awareness Tools

(a) While the Office of the Interconnection has overall responsibility for power system reliability in the ~~Office of the Interconnection~~ PJM Region, Transmission Owners within the ~~Office of the Interconnection~~ PJM Region perform ~~certain~~ specified reliability functions with respect to their individual Transmission Facilities and distribution systems. In order to facilitate reliable operations between the Office of the Interconnection and the Transmission Owners, the Office of the Interconnection may, without written authorization from any Member,

install a read-only terminal, or allow the Transmission Owner through a secure communication channel, in any Transmission Owner's secure control room facility, ~~with~~ to access ~~to~~ the Office of the Interconnection's Energy Management System (EMS), or its other reliability or situational awareness tools, and ~~its~~ the associated ~~data~~ transmission and generation data under the terms and conditions set forth in this section 18.17.6.

The eTariff section submitted with PJM's filing on November 17, 2020 did include the correct language. Therefore, PJM is not resubmitting the eTariff section.




