Dear Secretary Reese:

In accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") December 18, 2023 letter order issued in the above-captioned dockets,¹ PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("PJM") submits this compliance filing to notify the Commission of the January 1, 2024 effective date for the tariff records already accepted by the Commission in these proceedings.²

I. BACKGROUND

On November 1, 2023, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company ("FE PA"), and Keystone Appalachian Transmission Company ("KATCo") filed modifications to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff ("Tariff"), Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("Operating Agreement"), Reliability Assurance Agreement Among Load Serving Entities in the PJM Region ("RAA"), and the Consolidated Transmission Owners

Agreement (“CTOA”) (together, the “PJM Governing Agreements”) in connection with the integration of FE PA and KATCo into PJM as a result of FirstEnergy Corp.’s (“FirstEnergy’s”) proposed internal corporate reorganization (the “Transaction”) (“November 1 Filing”).³

At the time of the November 1 Filing, FE PA and KATCo anticipated that the Transaction would close on January 1, 2024, but the exact date was not certain. Thus, PJM requested an open-ended effective date of 12/31/9998 for the PJM Governing Agreements revisions attached to the November 1 Filing.

In the Letter Order, the Commission accepted the November 1 Filing effective 12/31/9998, as requested, subject to PJM submitting a compliance filing to notify the Commission of the actual effective date of the tariff records within 30 days of the effective date of the tariff records (*i.e.*, within 30 days of the FE PA and KATCo Transaction closing date).

II. INFORMATIONAL UPDATE AND REQUESTED EFFECTIVE DATE

On January 5, 2024, FirstEnergy submitted a filing to notify the Commission that the FE PA and KATCo Transaction was consummated on January 1, 2024.⁴ Therefore, consistent with the Commission’s directive in the Letter Order, PJM hereby notifies the Commission that the effective date for the revisions to the PJM Governing Agreements already accepted by the Commission in these proceedings are effective as of January 1, 2024.
